

Medical exemptions are purposely IMPOSSIBLE to attain. It is NOT up to ones medical doctor. It is up to OHA. Your child has to first almost DIE from a vaccine and suffer at least:

Severe allergic reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) after a previous dose or to a vaccine component

Encephalopathy (e.g., coma, decreased level of consciousness, prolonged seizures), not attributable to another identifiable cause, within 7 days of administration

Also, if your child does get the above vaccine injuries from one particular vaccine, you still are not necessarily exempt long term AND you are not exempt from all the other vaccines on the schedule that may have the same affect considering most vaccines contain aluminum.

Even with a family history of autoimmune diseases, aluminum poisoning in a vaccine injured parent and gene mutations that do not allow for proper detoxification, I am unable to attain a medical exemption for my child.

This bill does NOT protect families who need medical exemptions but can not get them.
