I am sorry to keep pestering you, but I am genuinely terrified; terrified my son, who LOVES school, has always been adored by his teachers, and has come so far with the services they have provided to make him a better reader, may be torn away from all of that, terrified of the financial implications facing our family, which relies on two incomes just to stay housed and fed, and terrified, above all, that I may be forced to have him undergo a medical procedure, that I, and his doctor KNOW (based on my health history, my husband's health history, and his own health circumstances) will harm him, possibly permanently.

But, what made me write to you again, imploring you to oppose this bill, is math. An unvaccinated child spends 99.9999999% of their entire life, non communicable. They don't just walk around infectious all the time. They might be infectious .00000001% of their life, and that's a solid maybe.

Is it worth removing 31,0000 children from public school on a MAYBE? Is it worth devastating THAT MANY families on a maybe?

Studies have shown that recently vaccinated individuals can shed viruses for something like 6 weeks; so hundreds of thousands of kids are walking around and going to school infectious?
