A friend of mine was 7 months pregnant, she went in for a check up, got a clean bill of health from the doctor, and a flu shot. 12 hours later her baby stopped moving; she went to the ER, her baby had died. She had to have her dead baby surgically removed.

Within 6 hours of receiving vaccines, my friend's 10 week old had a seizure and died in her arms.

Another 10 week old baby I knew stopped breathing 48 hours after receiving 6 vaccines. She died, and was resuscitated, she went into cardiac arrest, died and was resuscitated again, and again. She is alive, but has learning disabilities, and severe health issues.

Another friend of mine, was 30 years old, funny, vibrant, engaged to be married. She got a flu shot and died within minutes in the doctor's office. They said she had a heart condition she probably didn't even know about. Neither did they, because they don't screen for such things.

I know an EMT, and mother of 3. She told me she won't get her kids vaccinated because of all of the babies she has tried to resuscitate and failed, or had to rush to the ER with 72 hours of a receiving a vaccine.

My friend's youngest is fully vaccinated, he was diagnosed with jaundice at 3 days old, nearly declared failure to thrive. He is now 5 years old and has a severe obsessive disorder, learning disabilities and a rash all over his trunk- all the time. His teachers are talking about making him do kindergarten again because he is not hitting his marks.

In my son's preschool, there were about 50 kids, 4 of them had chronic seizures. One of them was my friend's daughter, who told me they started right after her 16 month vaccines. She also told me that her older child, also had chronic seizures, and extreme food allergies, she said his also began after his 16 month vaccines.

I worked in a pharmacy for several years, in the span of 30 days we had 3 newborns come in with acid reflux- something that up until recently was virtually unheard of.

I do not believe any of this is coincidence.

They say "correlation does not equal causation", and I'll buy that. But if you take a medicine or have a procedure that's listed side effects include X, Y or Z, and then you suddenly start suffering from X, Y or Z- it is logical to assume that the medicine or procedure had something to do with it.

I didn't need a celebrity to get me to distrust vaccines; the evidence was all around me.
