Paragraph 1. Section 8, Article II of the Constitution of the State of Oregon.

Sec. 8. (2) The Legislative Assembly, the governing body of a city, county, municipality or district empowered by law or by this Constitution to enact legislation (is the amendment necessary) or does it allow the Legislature to eliminate the voters right to a Referendum as declaring an emergency is currently used.
