WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Extends sunset date for nonresident open enrollment by five years, to July 1, 2024. Provides in-district residency to foreign exchange students who reside in dormitories operated by a school district, as specified. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon's open enrollment law was enacted by the Oregon legislature in 2011 and will sunset on July 1, 2019. Senate Bill 693 extends the sunset date by five years through the 2023-2024 school year. Open enrollment allows students who reside in one school district to attend school in a different district, under certain circumstances.
