WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Defines "preferred communication mode" and support service provider." Requires Department of Human Services (DHS) to administer a program to make support service providers available to individuals who are deaf-blind including visual and environmental information; sighted guide services; and communication accessible in the deaf-blind person's preferred language and communication mode. Requires DHS to adopt rules to administer the program including professional training and establishing a pay rate for support service providers. Requires DHS to provide funding technical assistance for training support service providers. Requires DHS to convene a stakeholder advisory committee. Allows DHS to accept gifts, grants or contributions.
