

Proposed Amendment to Senate Bill 48

Drafted by Jim Heuer, March 23, 2019

On page 1 of the printed bill, replace line 2 with the following:

“Relating to historic property; amending ORS 358.487 and ORS 358.499; and modifying criteria for acceptance, extends the expiration date, and prescribes the effective date for the historic property special assessment program.”

On page 1 of the printed bill, insert the following lines after line 3:

“SECTION 4. ORS 358.487 is amended to read:

(4)(a) Property must be classified as historic property in order to be certified for historic property special assessment.

(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, property may be certified for historic property special assessment upon a determination of eligibility by the State Historic Preservation Officer under ORS 358.480 (11)(b) or (c). Property certified under this paragraph must become listed in the National Register of Historic Places within two years of certification under ORS 358.490 **unless previously placed on a historic resource list as determined by rule and subject to historic resource protections under a program adopted by the jurisdiction in which it is located.**” [Added text in bold face]
