### STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS: ORS 185.610

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Membership should ensure, to the greatest extent possible, ethnic representation of Asian Americans in Oregon.
- Eleven members appointed for three-year terms
  - Nine members appointed by Governor; to the extent possible, members shall represent all areas of the state (AL-BAIATY, ALYAJOURI, ASAI, COX, LEUNG, MOSES-MESUBED, SINLAPASAI-OKAMURA, SONEOULAY-GILLESPIE)
  - One member appointed by the President of the Senate (DEMBROW)
  - One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives (PILUSO)

### DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 185.610 to 185.625

- Elect a chair and vice-chair
- Establish an Asian Affairs Network to facilitate the work of the commission
- Identify and examine the needs of Asian American residents of Oregon and compile information relating to services available to Asian American Oregonians
- Develop and sponsor programs in cooperation with Asian American groups and organizations to inform Asian Americans of services available to them
- Assess all programs of state agencies operating for the benefit of Asian American residents and make recommendations to the appropriate agencies for the improvement of those programs
- Submit a biennial report to the Governor describing the needs of Asian Americans and specifying the programs, projects and activities that the commission will undertake regarding those needs
- Work for the implementation and establishment of economic, social, legal and political equality for Asian Americans in Oregon and maintain a continuing assessment of the issues and needs confronting Asian Americans
- Meet annually with other Advocacy Commissions
