## APPOINTMENT/CONFIRMATION AUTHORITY: ORS 683.250

## STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTEREST REQUIRED (ORS 244.050): Not required

## STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS: ORS 683.250 and 683.260

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- The board has 5 members appointed by the governor for 3 year terms:
  - o Must have 4 must be doctors of optometry (CARDENEL, HUNT, LOUIE, TRONNES, WALKER)
  - o Must have 1 public member who represents health consumers (KLEIN)
- Public members may not be otherwise eligible for appointment to the Board; spouse, domestic partner, child, parent or sibling of a doctor of optometry; or have direct or indirect relationship to health care professionals, industry or ophthalmic optical industry
- A board member shall be removed immediately if the member is not a resident of the state, has been absent from three consecutive board meetings, without at least one excused absence, and not licensed and good standing at time of retirement
- An individual may not be a member of the Board:
  - If the person has a stockholder in, or owner of, or a member of a faculty of or of the board of trustees of any school of optometry; or
  - Has a financial interest in any purchase or contract in which the board is interested

#### DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 683.270 to 683.340

- The Board will organize and elect a president and vice-president
- Adopt and use a common seal
- Determine time and location of examination of applicants for licenses
- Will grant or refuse to grant licenses and impose sanctions
- Designate pharmaceutical agents for topical use in the practice of optometry
  - Adopt rules that are necessary and proper to carry out functions of the board including:
    - Establishment of license fees and license terms or duration
    - Determine the qualifications of applicants for a license and of licensees to practice optometry
    - o Establish educational and professional standards
- The Board may investigate complaints and take disciplinary action against a licensee
