

There are a ridiculous number of bills relating to firearms being considered by the legislature. Among them are: SB 275, SB 501, SB 87, SB 978, HB 2013, HB 2251, HB 2505, HB 2705, HB 2479, HB 3329, SB 5, SB 481, SB 539, HB 3223.
