WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Prohibits aerial application of pesticide to state forestlands.

BACKGROUND:

Under current Oregon law, a person may apply pesticides from an aircraft provided they hold a pesticide applicator's license and a license to operate the aircraft from which the pesticide is being applied.

Senate Bill 926 would prohibit aerial application of pesticide to state forestland.
