WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Youth Development Division (Division) to administer a pilot program to coordinate the deliver of services to youth between 6 and 21 years of age via Youth Development Hubs. Requires program to establish at least five Hubs, and that Hubs be located in at least five different counties. Requires Division to develop standards including guidelines for selecting Hub entities. Requires Division to consider the entities: 1) ability to engage community, 2) produce outcomes, 3) resourcefulness, and 4) use, or proposed use, of evidence-based practices. Requires Division to report on pilot program no later that September 15, 2024. Repeals Act on December 31, 2025.

The Youth Development Division is in Oregon Department of Education.
