Chair Dembrow and members of the committee:

I very very strongly support bills SB931 and SB 926. SB 931 will require a 24 hour notice of spraying pesticides, a very reasonable requirement so people can be prepared for these events by protecting water sources humans and animals. Also required are disclosures of the poisons being used to the people under the spray area so they can better report injuries to medical personnel.

SB 926 prohibits spraying pesticides on Oregon public lands. It is completely unacceptable that this state still allows this practice, since it was banned on federal lands years ago. Public lands supply drinking water to people and never should be polluted with poisonous chemicals.
