WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) coordinate with Oregon career and technical student organizations (CTSOs) to (1) encourage enrollment in CTSOs; (2) provide financial support (3) host annual competitive events (4) provide student recognition and awards; (5) plan and implement for Oregon State Fair; (6) and provide general and financial administration of CTSO programs. Requires ODE establish and administer grant program for allowing school districts to provide summer CTSO courses. Allows school district to qualify if district qualification are met, as specified. Requires district principal weekly schedule and monthly report outlining accomplishments, and file final report with ODE prior to beginning of following school year. Requires ODE collect data from each district to ensure compliance with grant requirements. Appropriates \$900,000 out of General Fund beginning July 1, 2019 for grant program. Declares emergency, takes effect July 1, 2019.

Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSOs) provide students with leadership opportunities in various educational fields. The organizations sponsor events in competition and leadership training for the purpose of building occupational skills, and understanding of civic responsibility. Some examples of CTSOs include Distributive Education Clubs of America, Future Business Leaders of America, Future Farmers of America, and SkillsUSA.
