Re: HB 3395

Distinguished Members,

<u>HB 3395</u> bill will allow medical cannabis growers in the CTS to transfer cannabis to any OMMP patient that holds a valid patient or caregiver card.

<u>HB 3395</u> will require a personal agreement between the grower and patient (ORS 475B.822)¹ and an OMMP Authorization to Transfer form (attached) and all transfers are required to be reported into the Cannabis Tracking System.

The end result of this bill is two-fold:

- <u>Reduce OMMP inventory</u>
 - OMMP inventory stands at any given time, somewhere between 25,000 and 40,000 pounds. This inventory is reported into the CTS but since OMMP growers have little access to market, it is hard to imagine this overstock is not a temptation to diversion to other less regulated markets.
- Allow OMMP growers to serve patients that have lost their grower
 - \circ $\:$ January 2017 Growers provided for 25,395 patients
 - January 2018 Growers provided for 13,000 patients
 - \circ $\;$ This number now stands at just under 4,800 patients.

In states with medical cannabis, Medicare costs drop by up to 25%. When patients are prevented from establishing a relationship with a grower, they are required to find other ways to procure their medications. When the state reduced access to medical growers, it forced those patients to obtain their medical cannabis from other sources including returning to their prescription medications they had eliminated by using cannabis. Here are some ways a patient that has lost their grower may find cannabis.

- Other patients, friends
- Underground markets
- OLCC retail stores
- Return to pharmaceutical medications

¹**475B.822 Personal agreements.** Notwithstanding ORS 475B.810 (7), a person responsible for a marijuana grow site may enter into an agreement with a registry identification cardholder under which the registry identification cardholder assigns, to the person responsible for the marijuana grow site, a portion of the right to possess the seeds, immature marijuana plants and usable marijuana that are the property of the registry identification cardholder.
