House Committee on Rules HB 3409, testimony in support April 3, 2019, at 3pm, in Hearing Room C

Chair Holvey, Vice-Chairs House Democratic Leaders Williamson and House Republican Leader Wilson, and members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on HB 3409 that implements policies to address bullying, racial taunting, and other behaviors at interscholastic events. We, the members of the Oregon Commission on Black Affairs in coalition with the Oregon Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs, Commission on Hispanic Affairs, and Commission for Women, believe that the HB 3409 provides the needed clarity for coaches, students, athletes, and spectators around such verbal assaults, and provides the authority and mechanism to apply them. As recent articles have described and the State School Board Chair's Op Ed and interview have outlined, these incidents are not uncommon. We are asking much of the affected student athletes to maintain demeanor and order among their teams or classmates in such toxic environments.

The leadership and maturity of the young men and women students who have experienced these assaults while remaining civil and self-contained for the good of the school and the team, must be reflected in state and school policies. The students are leading on this issue, and we commend the 2019 legislature for following their positive example and passing HB 3409.
