Measure Description:

Directs Department of State Lands to conduct study on issues related to wetlands mitigation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of State Lands (DSL)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Land Use to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation provides a blank General Fund appropriation, in the 2019-21 biennium, to the Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments to be used to hire employees to solicit bids and to contract for mitigation needs and the development of a local public wetland mitigation bank. Additionally, a blank General Fund appropriation, in the 2019-21 biennium, is provided to the Department of State Lands (DSL) to conduct a study on wetland mitigation and for providing responses to notices received from local governments.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
