**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2020**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “and 526.786” and insert “,
2 526.786, 801.041, 801.042, 802.500, 803.415, 803.420, 803.430, 803.440 and
3 818.010”.

4 In line 4, delete “declaring an emergency” and insert “prescribing an ef-
5 fective date”.

6 On page 9, line 33, after “to” insert a colon and delete the rest of the line.

7 Delete line 34 and insert:

8 “(A) Be dyed diesel; or

9 “(B) Have been used as aviation fuel or as fuel in watercraft or railroad
10 locomotives.”.

11 On page 23, delete lines 15 through 18 and insert:

12 “(a) By the department to issue refunds as provided for in sections 32a
13 and 32b of this 2019 Act; and

14 “(b) After making all valid refunds under paragraph (a) of this subsection,
15 to be allocated by the Legislative Assembly subject to sections 29 and 33 of
16 this 2019 Act.

17 “(4) Allocations by the Legislative Assembly under subsection (3)(b) of
18 this section must be for purposes:

19 “(a) Authorized by Article IX, section 3a, of the Oregon Constitution; and

20 “(b) That further the purposes set forth in section 7 of this 2019 Act.

21 **“SECTION 32a. (1) Any person that uses fuel to propel a motor ve-**

1 hicle registered under a farm vehicle registration pursuant to ORS
2 805.300 to 805.410 or a forest product vehicle registration pursuant to
3 sections 70 to 80 of this 2019 Act may apply to the Department of
4 Transportation for a refund equal to the number of gallons of fuel that
5 the person used to propel the motor vehicle during the immediately
6 preceding calendar year multiplied by 75 percent of the per gallon price
7 of an allowance, as that term is defined in section 8 of this 2019 Act.
8 The department shall calculate the per gallon price of an allowance
9 using the auction floor price for allowances in the year for which the
10 refund is claimed, as the auction floor price is set by the Carbon Policy
11 Office under section 21 of this 2019 Act.

12 “(b) An application for a refund under this subsection must be
13 submitted to the department by March 1 following the calendar year
14 to which the refund application relates.

15 “(c) The application required under this subsection shall be in a
16 form prescribed by the department by rule and must include a state-
17 ment, signed by the applicant under penalties for false swearing, that
18 sets forth the number of gallons of fuel proposed as the basis for
19 computing the amount of the refund.

20 “(d) The department may require the applicant for a refund under
21 this subsection to furnish any information the department considers
22 necessary for processing the application.

23 “(e) As used in this subsection, ‘fuel’ means:

24 “(A) Motor vehicle fuel as defined in ORS 319.010; and

25 “(B) Fuel subject to the tax imposed under ORS 319.530 on the use
26 of fuel in a motor vehicle within the meaning of ORS 319.520.

27 “(2)(a) The department may investigate a refund application sub-
28 mitted under subsection (1) of this section and gather and compile
29 such information related to the application as the department consid-
30 ers necessary.

1 “(b) The department may examine the relevant records of the ap-
2 plicant in order to establish the validity of an application.

3 “(c) If an applicant does not permit the department to examine the
4 relevant records, the applicant waives all rights to the refund to which
5 the application relates.

6 “(3)(a) The department shall reject or approve an application for a
7 refund submitted under subsection (1) of this section.

8 “(b) The department may modify an application to any reasonable
9 extent necessary for approval of the application.

10 “(c) If the department rejects or modifies an application, the de-
11 partment shall notify the applicant and explain the reasons for the
12 rejection or modification. An applicant may appeal a rejection or
13 modification, subject to the provisions of section 32b of this 2019 Act.

14 “(d) If the department approves an application, the department
15 shall notify the applicant and make the refund.

16 “SECTION 32b. Except as otherwise provided in section 32a of this
17 2019 Act, or where context requires otherwise, the provisions of ORS
18 chapters 305, 314 and 316 as to the audit and examination of reports
19 and returns, periods of limitation, determination of and notices of de-
20 ficiencies, assessments, collections, liens, delinquencies, claims for
21 refund and refunds, conferences, appeals to the Oregon Tax Court,
22 stays of collection pending appeal, confidentiality of returns and the
23 penalties and procedures relative thereto, apply to the determinations
24 of taxes, penalties and interest under section 32a of this 2019 Act.”.

25 On page 52, after line 22, insert:

27 **“FOREST PRODUCT VEHICLES REGISTRATION**

28
29 “SECTION 69. Sections 70 to 80 of this 2019 Act are added to and
30 made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

1 **“SECTION 70. Forest product vehicle registration; general require-**
2 **ments; fees.** (1) As used in this section:

3 “(a) ‘Forest products’ means any form, including but not limited
4 to timber, logs, poles, piles and peeler cores, into which a fallen tree
5 may be cut before it undergoes manufacturing.

6 “(b) ‘Timber producer’ means:

7 “(A) A person who owns forestland that is actively managed for
8 growing, harvesting or producing forest products; or

9 “(B) A person who grows, harvests or produces forest products.

10 “(2) A timber producer who is the owner of a motor vehicle may
11 apply to the Department of Transportation for and, upon payment of
12 appropriate fees, may receive forest product vehicle registration de-
13 scribed in this section to operate the vehicle. Forest product vehicle
14 registration is subject to the following as described:

15 “(a) Application is as provided under section 71 of this 2019 Act.

16 “(b) The fees are as provided under ORS 803.420.

17 “(c) The registration period is as provided under ORS 803.415.

18 “(3) Once registered under a forest product vehicle registration, a
19 vehicle may be used only for purposes described under section 78 of
20 this 2019 Act. Violation of limits imposed on use is punishable as pro-
21 vided under section 74 of this 2019 Act.

22 “(4) Transfer is subject to section 73 of this 2019 Act.

23 “(5) The registration may be canceled as provided under section 77
24 of this 2019 Act.

25 **“SECTION 71. Application for registration.** (1) As used in this sec-
26 tion, ‘forest products’ has the meaning given that term in section 70
27 of this 2019 Act.

28 “(2) Application for registration described under section 70 of this
29 2019 Act shall be made in a form prescribed by the Department of
30 Transportation and certified to by the applicant and shall include all

1 of the following:

2 “(a) The name and residence or business address of the applicant,
3 except as provided for Address Confidentiality Program participants in
4 ORS 192.846.

5 “(b) The type and amount of forest products, as defined in section
6 70 of this 2019 Act, produced annually on one or more of the forest
7 product operations upon which the motor vehicle sought to be regis-
8 tered is to be used.

9 “(c) The number of motor vehicles used on the one or more
10 forestlands upon which the motor vehicle sought to be registered is
11 to be used and the combined weight of the motor vehicle sought to be
12 registered.

13 “(d) A statement that any motor vehicle registered under section
14 70 of this 2019 Act:

15 “(A) Will be used only for one or more of the purposes specified
16 under section 78 of this 2019 Act.

17 “(B) Is needed in the operation of one or more forestlands.

18 “(e) Any other information required by the department.

19 “(f) Additional information required by law or by the department
20 in making an application for regular registration for the motor vehi-
21 cle.

22 “(3) The application shall contain a declaration that it is made un-
23 der penalties for false certification. Violation of this subsection is
24 subject to penalties under section 76 of this 2019 Act.

25 **“SECTION 72. Annual proof of qualification for forest product ve-**
26 **hicle registration.** The owner of a vehicle or combination that has four
27 or more axles and that is registered as a forest product vehicle under
28 section 70 of this 2019 Act shall annually show to the satisfaction of
29 the Department of Transportation that the owner qualifies for forest
30 product registration under section 70 of this 2019 Act.

1 **“SECTION 73. Effect of sale of vehicle.** Upon sale of a vehicle reg-
2 **istered under section 70 of this 2019 Act, before operation of the vehicle**
3 **on a highway, the new owner must reregister the vehicle unless the**
4 **new owner also qualifies as a timber producer as described in section**
5 **70 of this 2019 Act.**

6 **“SECTION 74. Violation of forest product registration limits; pen-**
7 **alty.** (1) A person commits the offense of violation of forest product
8 **registration limits if the person uses or owns and permits to be used**
9 **a forest product vehicle registered under section 70 of this 2019 Act for**
10 **purposes other than the uses described under section 78 of this 2019**
11 **Act.**

12 **“(2) The offense described in this section, violation of forest product**
13 **registration limits, is a Class A misdemeanor.**

14 **“SECTION 75. Failure to register forest product vehicle properly;**
15 **penalty.** (1) A person commits the offense of failure to register a forest
16 **product vehicle properly if the person is the new owner of a vehicle**
17 **with registration under section 70 of this 2019 Act, and the person op-**
18 **erates the vehicle before properly registering it.**

19 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a person from registering the**
20 **vehicle under section 70 of this 2019 Act if the person is qualified.**

21 **“(3) The offense described in this section, failure to register a forest**
22 **product vehicle properly, is a Class A misdemeanor.**

23 **“SECTION 76. False certification; penalty.** (1) A person commits the
24 **offense of false certification on forest product vehicle registration if**
25 **the person knowingly certifies falsely to any information on any ap-**
26 **plication for issuance of registration under section 71 of this 2019 Act.**

27 **“(2) The offense described in this section, false certification on for-**
28 **est product vehicle registration, is a Class A misdemeanor.**

29 **“SECTION 77. Department investigation; cancellation.** The Depart-
30 **ment of Transportation shall have the authority to investigate and**

1 verify information provided in conjunction with application for regis-
2 tration under section 70 of this 2019 Act. The department may cancel
3 the registration of any vehicle that has registration issued under sec-
4 tion 70 of this 2019 Act if the owner or a lessee of the vehicle, or an
5 employee of either, is convicted of violation of section 74, 75 or 76 of
6 this 2019 Act, if the department determines that such person has vio-
7 lated section 74, 75 or 76 of this 2019 Act, whether or not the person
8 is convicted for the violation or the department determines that either
9 the vehicle or the owner no longer qualifies for forest product vehicle
10 registration. If registration is canceled under this section, the vehicle
11 is not eligible for registration under section 70 of this 2019 Act for a
12 period of one year after the cancellation.

13 **SECTION 78. Permitted uses of forest product vehicles.** (1) As used
14 in this section, ‘forest products’ has the meaning given that term in
15 section 70 of this 2019 Act.

16 **“(2) The following uses are permitted for forest product vehicles**
17 **registered under section 70 of this 2019 Act and for vehicles authorized**
18 **by section 79 of this 2019 Act to be registered under ORS 826.009 or**
19 **826.011:**

20 **“(a) The vehicles may be used to transport forest products har-**
21 **vested by a person who owns or permits use of the vehicles.**

22 **“(b) The vehicles may be used in any transportation that is inci-**
23 **dental to regular forest product production operations.**

24 **“(c) The vehicles may be used to transport supplies, equipment or**
25 **materials to a forestland.**

26 **“(d) The vehicles may be used to transport products, supplies,**
27 **equipment or materials for another person who qualifies under this**
28 **section on an exchange of labor basis if such products, supplies,**
29 **equipment or materials are to be used by the other person.**

30 **“(e) The vehicles may be operated for the personal use of the per-**

1 son, any member of the person's immediate family or any person in
2 the person's employ.

3 “(f) The vehicles may be rented or borrowed by a person to haul the
4 person's own products if the person would qualify for a forest product
5 vehicle registration for vehicles of the type and size rented or bor-
6 rowed.

7 **“SECTION 79. Proportional registration for timber production ve-**
8 **hicles; rules.** (1) Any person who qualifies under section 70 of this 2019
9 Act for forest product vehicle registration may choose to register
10 qualified vehicles under the proportional registration provisions of
11 ORS 826.009 or 826.011 in lieu of registering the vehicles under section
12 70 of this 2019 Act. Except as otherwise provided in this section, forest
13 product vehicles registered under ORS 826.009 or 826.011 are subject to
14 the same requirements, conditions and privileges as other vehicles
15 registered under those sections. Forest product vehicle proportional
16 registration is subject to the following:

17 “(a) In addition to any application for registration required by ORS
18 826.009 or 826.011, the applicant must submit an application to the De-
19 partment of Transportation certified by the applicant and containing
20 the information specified in section 71 of this 2019 Act for forest
21 product vehicle registration.

22 “(b) The department shall issue appropriate identification devices
23 for proportionally registered forest product vehicles. The design for
24 such devices shall be determined by the department by rule and the
25 fees for such devices are as provided in ORS 803.577.

26 “(c) An identification device for proportionally registered forest
27 product vehicles is subject to cancellation as provided in section 80 of
28 this 2019 Act.

29 “(2) The vehicles may be used only for purposes described in section
30 78 of this 2019 Act. Violation of this paragraph is punishable as pro-

1 vided in section 74 of this 2019 Act for violation of forest product reg-
2 istration limits.

3 **“SECTION 80. Department investigation of forest product vehicle**
4 **proportional registration application; cancellation.** (1) The Department
5 of Transportation shall have the authority to investigate and verify
6 information provided in conjunction with application for proportional
7 registration of a forest product vehicle under section 79 of this 2019
8 Act. The department may cancel an identification device for a pro-
9 portionally registered forest product vehicle if the department deter-
10 mines that the owner or lessee of the vehicle, or an employee of either,
11 has:

12 **“(a) Operated the vehicle in violation of forest product vehicle reg-**
13 **istration limits; or**

14 **“(b) Falsely certified an application required by section 79 of this**
15 **2019 Act for registration or renewal of registration of a proportionally**
16 **registered forest product vehicle.**

17 **“(2) If a forest product vehicle proportional registration identifica-**
18 **tion device is canceled under this section, the vehicle is not eligible**
19 **for registration under section 70 of this 2019 Act for a period of one**
20 **year after the cancellation.**

22 **“CONFORMING AMENDMENTS**

23

24 **“SECTION 81.** ORS 801.041, as amended by section 1, chapter 24, Oregon
25 Laws 2018, and section 24, chapter 93, Oregon Laws 2018, is amended to read:

26 **“801.041.** The following apply to the authority granted to counties by ORS
27 801.040 to establish registration fees for vehicles:

28 **“(1) An ordinance establishing registration fees under this section must**
29 **be enacted by the county imposing the registration fee and filed with the**
30 **Department of Transportation. Notwithstanding ORS 203.055 or any pro-**

1 vision of a county charter, the governing body of a county with a population
2 of 350,000 or more may enact an ordinance establishing registration fees. The
3 governing body of a county with a population of less than 350,000 may enact
4 an ordinance establishing registration fees after submitting the ordinance to
5 the electors of the county for their approval. The governing body of the
6 county imposing the registration fee shall enter into an intergovernmental
7 agreement under ORS 190.010 with the department by which the department
8 shall collect the registration fees, pay them over to the county and, if nec-
9 essary, allow the credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The inter-
10 governmental agreement must state the date on which the department shall
11 begin collecting registration fees for the county.

12 “(2) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of
13 registration fees in addition to those described in ORS 803.420 and 803.422.
14 There is no authority under this section to affect registration periods, qual-
15 ifications, cards, plates, requirements or any other provision relating to ve-
16 hicle registration under the vehicle code.

17 “(3) Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, when registration
18 fees are imposed under this section, they must be imposed on all vehicle
19 classes. Registration fees as provided under this section may not be imposed
20 on the following:

21 “(a) Snowmobiles and Class I all-terrain vehicles.

22 “(b) Fixed load vehicles.

23 “(c) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 to disabled veterans.

24 “(d) Vehicles registered as antique vehicles under ORS 805.010.

25 “(e) Vehicles registered as vehicles of special interest under ORS 805.020.

26 “(f) Government-owned or operated vehicles registered under ORS 805.040
27 or 805.045.

28 “(g) School buses or school activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.050.

29 “(h) Law enforcement undercover vehicles registered under ORS 805.060.

30 “(i) Vehicles registered on a proportional basis for interstate operation.

1 “(j) Vehicles with a registration weight of 26,001 pounds or more de-
2 scribed in ORS 803.420 (14)(a) or (b).

3 “(k) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under the provisions of ORS
4 805.300.

5 “(L) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes.

6 “(m) Vehicles registered to an employment address as provided in ORS
7 802.250 when the eligible public employee or household member’s residence
8 address is not within the county of the employment address. The department
9 may adopt rules it considers necessary for the administration of this para-
10 graph.

11 “(n) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.110 to former prisoners of war.

12 “(o) **Vehicles registered as forest product vehicles under section 70**
13 **of this 2019 Act.**

14 “(4) Any registration fee imposed by a county must be a fixed amount not
15 to exceed, with respect to any vehicle class, the sum of the registration fee
16 established under ORS 803.420 (6)(a) and the fee applicable to the registered
17 vehicle under ORS 803.422. For vehicles on which a flat fee is imposed under
18 ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar amount.

19 “(5) Moneys from registration fees established under this section must be
20 paid to the county establishing the registration fees as provided in ORS
21 802.110.

22 “(6) The county ordinance shall provide for payment of at least 40 percent
23 of the moneys to cities within the county unless a different distribution is
24 agreed upon by the county and the cities within the jurisdiction of the
25 county.

26 “(7) The moneys for the cities and the county shall be used for any pur-
27 pose for which moneys from registration fees may be used, including the
28 payment of debt service and costs related to bonds or other obligations is-
29 sued for such purposes.

30 “(8) Two or more counties may act jointly to impose a registration fee

1 under this section. The ordinance of each county acting jointly with another
2 under this subsection must provide for the distribution of moneys collected
3 through a joint registration fee.

4 **“SECTION 82.** ORS 801.042, as amended by section 25, chapter 93, Oregon
5 Laws 2018, is amended to read:

6 “801.042. The following apply to the authority granted to a district by
7 ORS 801.040 to establish registration fees for vehicles:

8 “(1) Before the governing body of a district can impose a registration fee
9 under this section, it must submit the proposal to the electors of the district
10 for their approval and, if the proposal is approved, enter into an intergov-
11 ernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the governing bodies of all
12 counties, other districts and cities with populations of over 300,000 that
13 overlap the district. The intergovernmental agreement must state the regis-
14 tration fees and, if necessary, how the revenue from the fees shall be appor-
15 tioned among counties and the districts. Before the governing body of a
16 county can enter into such an intergovernmental agreement, the county shall
17 consult with the cities in its jurisdiction.

18 “(2) If a district raises revenues from a registration fee for purposes re-
19 lated to highways, roads, streets and roadside rest areas, the governing body
20 of that district shall establish a Regional Arterial Fund and shall deposit in
21 the Regional Arterial Fund all such registration fees.

22 “(3) Interest received on moneys credited to the Regional Arterial Fund
23 shall accrue to and become a part of the Regional Arterial Fund.

24 “(4) The Regional Arterial Fund must be administered by the governing
25 body of the district referred to in subsection (2) of this section and such
26 governing body by ordinance may disburse moneys in the Regional Arterial
27 Fund. Moneys within the Regional Arterial Fund may be disbursed only for
28 a program of projects recommended by a joint policy advisory committee on
29 transportation consisting of local officials and state agency representatives
30 designated by the district referred to in subsection (2) of this section. The

1 projects for which the joint policy advisory committee on transportation can
2 recommend funding must concern arterials, collectors or other improvements
3 designated by the joint policy advisory committee on transportation.

4 “(5) Ordinances establishing registration fees under this section must be
5 filed with the Department of Transportation. The governing body of the dis-
6 trict imposing the registration fee shall enter into an intergovernmental
7 agreement under ORS 190.010 with the department by which the department
8 shall collect the registration fees, pay them over to the district and, if nec-
9 essary, allow the credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The inter-
10 governmental agreement must state the date on which the department shall
11 begin collecting registration fees for the district.

12 “(6) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of
13 registration fees in addition to those described in ORS 803.420 and 803.422.
14 There is no authority under this section to affect registration periods, qual-
15 ifications, cards, plates, requirements or any other provision relating to ve-
16 hicle registration under the vehicle code.

17 “(7) Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, when registration
18 fees are imposed under this section, the fees must be imposed on all vehicle
19 classes. Registration fees as provided under this section may not be imposed
20 on the following:

21 “(a) Snowmobiles and Class I all-terrain vehicles.

22 “(b) Fixed load vehicles.

23 “(c) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 to disabled veterans.

24 “(d) Vehicles registered as antique vehicles under ORS 805.010.

25 “(e) Vehicles registered as vehicles of special interest under ORS 805.020.

27 or 805.045.

28 “(g) School buses or school activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.050.

29 “(h) Law enforcement undercover vehicles registered under ORS 805.060.

30 “(i) Vehicles registered on a proportional basis for interstate operation.

1 “(j) Vehicles with a registration weight of 26,001 pounds or more de-
2 scribed in ORS 803.420 (14)(a) or (b).

3 “(k) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under the provisions of ORS
4 805.300.

5 “(L) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes.

6 “(m) Vehicles registered to an employment address as provided in ORS
7 802.250 when the eligible public employee or household member’s residence
8 address is not within the county of the employment address. The department
9 may adopt rules it considers necessary for the administration of this para-
10 graph.

11 “(n) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.110 to former prisoners of war.

12 “(o) **Vehicles registered as forest product vehicles under section 70**
13 **of this 2019 Act.**

14 “(8) Any registration fee imposed by the governing body of a district must
15 be a fixed amount not to exceed, with respect to any vehicle class, the reg-
16 istration fee established under ORS 803.420 (6)(a) and the fee applicable to
17 the registered vehicle under ORS 803.422. For vehicles on which a flat fee
18 is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar amount.

19 “**SECTION 83.** ORS 802.500 is amended to read:

20 “802.500. The Director of Transportation may enter into agreements with
21 the duly authorized representatives of any jurisdiction that issues registra-
22 tion to establish reciprocal privileges or registration exemptions for vehicles
23 as described in this section. All of the following apply to an agreement es-
24 tablished under the authority granted by this section:

25 “(1) An agreement may establish any of the following benefits, privileges
26 and exemptions with respect to the operation of commercial or noncommer-
27 cial vehicles in this state:

28 “(a) For purposes of ORS 803.305 exemptions from registration and pay-
29 ment, wholly or partially, of any vehicle or registration fees.

30 “(b) Privileges relating to vehicles used by persons with disabilities.

1 “(c) Privileges relating to vehicle parking.

2 “(d) Privileges relating to vehicle dealers.

3 “(e) Privileges, exemptions or benefits relating to farm vehicles or imple-
4 ments of husbandry.

5 “(f) Privileges relating to persons commercially transporting vehicles.

6 “(g) Any similar privileges, benefits or exemptions relating to the opera-
7 tion of vehicles.

8 “(h) Privileges, benefits or exemptions relating to the registration of
9 fleets of vehicles.

10 “(i) **Privileges, exemptions or benefits relating to forest product**
11 **vehicles.**

12 “(2) An agreement shall only grant the privileges, benefits and exemptions
13 to a vehicle or the owner of a vehicle if the vehicle is any of the following:

14 “(a) Registered in the jurisdiction where the person registering the vehi-
15 cle has a legal residence.

16 “(b) A commercial vehicle registered in a jurisdiction where the commer-
17 cial enterprise in which the vehicle is used has a place of business. To
18 qualify under this paragraph the vehicle must be assigned to the place of
19 business and the place of business must be the place from which or in which
20 the vehicle is most frequently dispatched, garaged, serviced, maintained, op-
21 erated or otherwise controlled.

22 “(c) A commercial vehicle registered in a jurisdiction where the vehicle
23 has been registered because of an agreement between two jurisdictions or a
24 declaration issued by any jurisdiction.

25 “(3) An agreement shall retain the right of the Department of Transpor-
26 tation to make the final determination as to the proper place of registration
27 of a vehicle when there is a dispute or doubt concerning the proper place
28 of registration. An agreement shall retain the right of the department to
29 confer with the departments of other jurisdictions affected when making a
30 determination under this subsection.

1 “(4) An agreement shall not provide for any benefit, exemption or privi-
2 lege with respect to fuel taxes, use fuel taxes, weight mile taxes or any other
3 fees or taxes levied or assessed against the use of highways or use or own-
4 ership of vehicles except registration taxes, fees and requirements.

5 “(5) An agreement must provide that any vehicle registered in this state
6 will receive a similar kind or degree of exemptions, benefits and privileges
7 when operated in another jurisdiction that is party to the agreement as ve-
8 hicles registered in the other jurisdiction receive when operated in this state.

9 “(6) An agreement, in the judgment of the director, shall be in the best
10 interest of this state and its citizens, shall be fair and equitable to this state
11 and its citizens and shall be determined on the basis and recognition of
12 benefits that accrue to the economy of this state from the uninterrupted flow
13 of commerce.

14 “(7) An agreement may authorize a vehicle that would otherwise be re-
15 quired to be registered in one jurisdiction to be registered in another juris-
16 diction without losing any benefit, exemption or privilege under the
17 agreement if the vehicle is operated from a base located in the other juris-
18 diction.

19 “(8) An agreement may allow the lessee or lessor of a vehicle, subject to
20 the terms and conditions of the lease to receive benefits, exemptions and
21 privileges under the agreement.

22 “(9) An agreement may authorize the department to suspend or cancel any
23 exceptions, benefits or privileges granted to any person under the agreement
24 if the person violates any of the terms or conditions of the agreement or
25 violates any law or rule of this state relating to vehicles.

26 “(10) All agreements shall be in writing and filed with the department
27 within 10 days after execution or the effective date of the agreement,
28 whichever is later.

29 “(11) An agreement may be a limited type agreement with any state bor-
30 dering this state as described in this subsection. An agreement described

1 under this subsection is subject to all of the following:

2 “(a) The benefits, exemptions and privileges under the agreement shall
3 only be extended to vehicles or a class of vehicles as specified in the agree-
4 ment.

5 “(b) The agreement shall be applicable only within an area in each state
6 that is situated along the boundary between the states and that is substan-
7 tially equal in size.

8 “(c) The usage permitted of the vehicles in the two areas shall be as
9 substantially equal as may be practicable.

10 “(d) The areas and usage subject to the agreement shall be described in
11 the agreement.

12 “(e) Proportional registration shall not be required under the agreement.

13 “(f) The agreement shall comply with other mandatory provisions of this
14 section and may contain any other provisions described under this section.

15 “(g) A vehicle operating under the agreement may be required to obtain
16 a permit under ORS 803.610.

17 “(12) An agreement may require the display or submission of evidence of
18 registration for any vehicle operating under the agreement.

19 **“SECTION 84.** ORS 803.430 is amended to read:

20 “803.430. (1) Registration weight is established for the following purposes:

21 “(a) The registration weight is the weight used in the declaration of
22 weight under ORS 803.435 to determine the registration fees under ORS
23 803.420 for vehicles required to establish registration weight under this sec-
24 tion.

25 “(b) A vehicle that is required to establish registration weight by this
26 section is in violation of ORS 803.315 if the vehicle is operated on a highway
27 of this state at a weight in excess of the registration weight except when
28 carrying a load:

29 “(A) Under the provisions of ORS 376.305 to 376.390;

30 “(B) Of over 105,500 pounds combined weight or loaded weight under a

1 variance permit issued under ORS 818.200;

2 “(C) Under a registration weight trip permit issued under ORS 803.600;
3 or

4 “(D) Consisting of towed motor vehicles required to be registered under
5 the vehicle code.

6 “(2) Registration weight is established at the time of registration and
7 whenever the vehicle has been altered or reconstructed by furnishing a dec-
8 laration of weight described under ORS 803.435 that contains a declaration
9 of the maximum combined weight or loaded weight at which the vehicle will
10 be operated on the highways of this state except when carrying loads de-
11 scribed under subsection (1)(b) of this section. The maximum registration
12 weight for any vehicle required to establish a registration weight under this
13 section is 105,500 pounds. Vehicles operating at weights above 105,500 pounds
14 will operate under a variance permit issued under ORS 818.200.

15 “(3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, the following
16 vehicles are required to establish a registration weight under this section:

17 “(a) Any motor truck that will be operated on the highways at a combined
18 weight or loaded weight of more than 10,000 pounds not including the weight
19 of any camper or trailing vehicle described in subsection (5) of this section,
20 or any trailing manufactured structure.

21 “(b) Any truck tractor that will be operated on the highways at a com-
22 bined weight of more than 8,000 pounds not including the weight of any
23 camper or trailing vehicle described in subsection (5) of this section, or any
24 trailing manufactured structure.

25 “(c) An armored car, tow vehicle, hearse or ambulance.

26 “(d) Any other motor vehicle that will be operated on the highways at a
27 combined weight or loaded weight of more than 10,000 pounds not including
28 the weight of any camper or trailing vehicle as described in subsection (5)
29 of this section, or any trailing manufactured structure.

30 “(e) A self-propelled mobile crane.

1 “(f) Any motor vehicle registered as a farm vehicle under ORS 805.300.

2 “(g) Any vehicle registered as a forest product vehicle under section
3 **70 of this 2019 Act.**

4 “(4) A vehicle that is being registered under a specific provision of the
5 vehicle code where fees are not based on weight or where registration weight
6 is specifically not required is not required to establish registration weight
7 under this section.

8 “(5) The weight of a camper or the following trailing vehicles may not
9 be included in the registration weight:

10 “(a) Trailers with a loaded weight of 8,000 pounds or less.

11 “(b) Special use trailers, travel trailers and fixed load vehicles.

12 “(c) Towed motor vehicles.

13 “(6) The weight of a trailing manufactured structure may not be included
14 in the registration weight.

15 “**SECTION 85.** ORS 803.440 is amended to read:

16 “803.440. (1) A person commits the offense of failure to submit a declara-
17 tion of weight if the person does not submit a declaration of weight for a
18 vehicle described in this subsection when the person applies for registration
19 of the vehicle or has the vehicle registered in the person’s name and the
20 vehicle has been altered or reconstructed. This section applies to the fol-
21 lowing vehicles:

22 “(a) Any vehicle required to establish registration weight under ORS
23 803.430.

24 “(b) Any commercial bus.

25 “(c) Any vehicle registered as a farm vehicle under ORS 805.300.

26 “(d) Any vehicle registered under the proportional registration provisions
27 of ORS 826.009 or 826.011.

28 “(e) Any vehicle registered as a forest product vehicle under section

30 “(2) The offense described in this section, failure to submit a declaration

1 of weight, is a Class D traffic violation.

2 **“SECTION 86.** ORS 803.415 is amended to read:

3 “803.415. This section establishes registration periods for vehicles. The
4 registration periods are periods described under ORS 803.400. Except as pro-
5 vided in the following, the registration period for any vehicle registered in
6 this state by the Department of Transportation is a biennial registration
7 period:

8 “(1) The following vehicles have permanent registration:

9 “(a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010.

10 “(b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020.

11 “(c) Trailers that will be operated on the highways at a loaded weight of
12 more than 8,000 pounds and are not travel trailers, fixed load vehicles or
13 special use trailers.

22 “(c) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.

23 **“(d) Vehicles registered as forest product vehicles under section 70**

25 “(4) Snowmobiles are registered as provided in ORS 821.080.

26 “(5) Vehicles operated by dealers who hold certificates under ORS 822.020
27 are as provided under ORS 822.040.

28 “(6) Trailers for hire that will be operated at a loaded weight of 8,000
29 pounds or less may be registered as follows:

30 “(a) Annual registration; or

1 “(b) If registered under an agreement pursuant to ORS 802.500, for a pe-
2 riod of time determined as specified in the agreement or as determined by
3 the department.

4 “(7) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (10) of this section, the
5 registration period for electric vehicles and hybrid vehicles that use elec-
6 tricity and another source of motive power is a biennial registration period
7 except that the registration period for the following electric or hybrid vehi-
8 cles is an annual registration period:

9 “(a) Commercial buses.

10 “(b) Electric or hybrid vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS
11 805.300.

12 “(c) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430.

13 “(8) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 have an ownership registration
14 period.

15 “(9) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050 have ownership regis-
16 tration except that the registration shall continue to be valid if ownership
17 of the vehicle is transferred to a person who continues to use the vehicle for
18 purposes authorized by ORS 805.050.

19 “(10) The following vehicles have a four-year registration period:

20 “(a) New vehicles registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(a) for which new reg-
21 istration plates will be issued;

22 “(b) New mopeds or motorcycles registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(c) for
23 which new registration plates will be issued; and

24 “(c) New trailers registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(b), for which new reg-
25 istration plates will be issued.
