Measure Description:

Requires school district that provides breakfast to make breakfast available after start of school day.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education (ODE), School Districts

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis: This bill requires a school district that provides breakfast to make breakfast available after the start of the school day for an additional 15 minutes.

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) does not anticipate significant additional staff time as a result of this bill. Some internal processes and reporting will likely be required but should be absorbed in the current workload. Even though, some schools have implemented this change already, school districts are still concerned that this will take away from instructional time.

Providing additional time may increase participation rates and increase reimbursements from the Federal School Lunch program. The Federal School Lunch program consists of Non-Limited Federal, so no additional General Fund is required.
