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**Measure Description:**

Establishes Universal School Meal Account for purpose of reimbursing school districts for certain costs incurred in providing federally reimbursable meals.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Education (ODE), School Districts, Education Service Districts (ESD)

**Analysis:** This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Student Success.

The measure establishes the Universal School Meals Account to reimburse school districts for the United State Department of Agriculture for meals not reimbursed by state, federal, or other sources. The bill does not identify a funding source for the new Universal School Meal Account. The Oregon Department of Education anticipates any costs associated with rule making and administering the new account and program can be absorbed by the existing staff.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Department of Education, School Districts, and Education Service Districts.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Student Success.
