**Measure Description:**

Allows local governments to develop historic resource program to designate resources for protection.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD), Counties, Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The legislation authorizes a local government to adopt a historic resource program that fosters and encourages the identification, designation, and protection of historic resources consistent with statewide land use planning goals and rules.
