

Article XV, Section 3 of the Oregon Constitution provides that [E]very person elected or appointed to any office under this Constitution shall, before entering on the duties thereof, take an oath or affirmation to support the Constitution of the United States, and of this State, and also an oath of office."

My name is Grant Nelson and I am born and raised in Oregon and I am a land owning, voting taxpayer. I have come a good ways to stand before this legislature and hold you to your promise not to infringe on my RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS. Oregon's Constitution Article I Section 27 The people shall have the right to bear arms for the defence [sic] of themselves, I see nothing in the 2019 Firearms Legislation that in any way secures my RIGHT TO SELF DEFENCE. April Fools Day was yesterday, not today, and the people of this State have been played for a fool long enough. Oregon Constitution Article I Section 20; No law shall be passed granting to any citizen or class of citizens privileges or immunities, which, upon the same terms, shall not equally belong to all citizens.-- ORS 166.250....A person commits the crime of unlawful possession of a firearm if the person knowingly

(a) Carries any firearm concealed upon the person;

(b) Possesses a handgun that is concealed and readily accessible to the person within any vehicle;

ORS.260 (1)ORS.250 does not apply to or affect: (a) Sheriffs, constables, marshals, parole and probation officers, police officers, whether active or honorably retired, or other duly appointed peace officers. Laws against a free person possessing firearms for self-defence are facially unconstitutional when the State converts a right into a privilege and requires a license or a fee for the exercise of the right. Murock v. Pennsylvania, 319 US 105 Oregon gun laws are Orwellian in nature because they make some people more equal than others.
