I moved from Michigan, and watched the state slowly slide from a leader in public education to the bottom third of all US states, in part as the state slowly funneled away funds . I am writing to ask you to support fully funding Oregon schools. The proposal currently released is a significant start toward that goal, and I would like to see it passed before adjourning.
