SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Department of Revenue Collections Division Feasibility Study

On March 26th, the General Government Subcommittee recommended acknowledging receipt of a report from the Department of Revenue on a Collections Division Feasibility Study.

The Department examined the feasibility of consolidating of all the agency's collection functions into a single division. The Department currently has a decentralized debt collection model across the personal income tax and business divisions.

The Department's proposed plan, based on its study, is to consolidation all the agency's collection functions into a single division over the course of the next two biennia. The Department anticipates that this will lead to more consistent collection efforts that should improve collections while reducing costs.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends approval.
