I am a farmer in Oregon. I oppose HB 3427. Getting tax policy right is crucial.

There are many problems with HB 3427.

• Farmers and ranchers have to pay the added tax on all farm inputs but can't pass along the costs.

• Agriculture Co-Ops and their farmer owners will be double or triple taxed.

• While on highway fuel is excluded, off-road fuels will be tax before delivered to my farm, adding another cost to fuel.
