OYCP Expansion

- Long term desire and need to expand the Oregon Youth Challenge Program
- Provides the opportunity for more of Oregon's at-risk youth to get their education back on track
- Prior to construction housed a maximum of 156 cadets
 - o 36 females and 120 males
- After construction OYCP will house 240 cadets
 - o goal is 120 females and 120 males



Project History

- 2015 Legislature approved bond sales for \$4.977M
- Oct 2017: Contract was awarded to:
 - Contractor: Kirby Nagelhout (Central Oregon)
 - Design: Hennebery Eddy Architects (Portland)
- Mar 2017: Bonds sold (Tax-exempt)
 - Subsequently swapped for Taxable bonds in Nov 2017
- Feb 2018: Design team presented drawings to OMD
- Proposed drawings \$5.254 M over budget
- OMD began moving forward with a revised renovation plan



Federal Investment

- OMD was successful in securing an additional \$5.3M Federal Funds end of 2018 Federal Fiscal Year
- The Federal Funds required a 25% State match
- OMD used a portion of the \$4.977M to leverage the Federal Funds.
- December 2018 E-Board approved increased federal limitation







Construction Budget

- \$4.977M State Bonds
- \$5.3M Federal (required a State match of 25%)
 - \$1,766,667 (State match)
- Total expansion budget = \$10,277,000



Construction Phase 1

- Three 60 person dormitories
 - Remodeled 2 existing dormitories
 - Demo supply storage rooms and built 1 new dormitory
- Renovated / enlarged dining area









Construction Phase 2

- Expand female restroom / shower
- Build a new male restroom / shower
- Build one more 60 person dormitory (female)
- Build two new classrooms
- Renovate four existing classrooms and the computer lab
- Build operations administration area
- Renovate existing teachers administrative area
- Renovate and increase the size of the kitchen
- Renovate and double the size of the laundry room







Phased Increase in Cadet Capacity

2019

Jan to Jun: 165 Cadets

Jul to Dec: 165 Cadets

2020

Jan to Jun: 180 Cadets

Jul to Dec: 240 Cadets

 Tentative ribbon cutting ceremony is 15 Jan 20.
