PLEASE urge all the lawmakers to ACT NOW while there's still a chance and correct the draining of our future. Please support FULL funding for K-12 education as well as pre-k, and 2 and 4 year colleges! Please create new revenue sources that will stabilize the boom and bust cycle of Oregon schools.

I'm particularly passionate about the following which are all at risk with funding cuts:

- I believe librarians, music and arts programs are critical to the development of our children, especially the youngest.
