2019-21 Governor's Budget By Fund Type

Policy Package 301 OEM Position Fund Shift

Description:

- Fund shift 11 OEM positions to 100% General Fund
- Federal Funds cannot pay for indirect payroll costs in OEM
- FTE: 0

Impact if not approved:

 OEM will lose all executive service, management and administrative support positions. OEM's Emergency Management mission capabilities will be decimated.

- General Fund \$2,306,375
- Other Funds (\$873,515)
- Federal Funds (\$1,415,350)



Policy Package 201 PANG Over-Cap and Utilities

Description:

- \$98K GF for payroll costs on 7 positions that exceed the federal pay cap and collective bargaining costs.
- \$177K GF for utilities and operational S&S.
- FTE: 0

Impacts if not approved:

- Up to 10 employee layoffs (48% of 21 total staff).
- Increased deferred maintenance.
- Decreased ability to perform mission.



- General Fund \$275,000
- Federal Funds \$707,960



Policy Package 202 New Installations Div. Positions

Description:

- 14 wildland fire positions (12 seasonal),
- 4 maintenance/construction positions,
- 1 accountant, 1 procurement spec,
- 3 accounting tech/office specialist/info systems tech positions at Camp Rilea
- 1 LD Pgm Analyst 2 for Physical Security
- 2 reclasses of facility positions
- FTE: 19.00, Positions: 24

Impacts if not approved:

- Inadequate wildfire coverage for training exercises at Camp Umatilla.
- Insufficient facility maintenance at Camp Withycombe and Pendleton Army Guard flight facility.
- Delays in billeting and accounting functions at Camp Rilea.



- Other Funds \$193,354
- Federal Funds \$2,633,694



Policy Package 401 YCP Expansion Phase 2

Description:

- Phase 2 = 60 additional cadets (goal is 240: 120 females, 120 males)
- 14 new positions phased-in April 2020
- 2 new contract teachers
- \$244,000 one-time GF for 3 month staff training
- \$200K GF, \$768K FF for increased S&S
- FTE: 8.82, Positions: 14

Impacts if not approved:

- Without sufficient staff levels or funding, would be unable to bring on 60 additional cadets
- Limits options for at-risk youth



- General Fund \$444,000
- Other Funds \$305,185
- Federal Funds \$1,683,492



Policy Package 203 KF Over-Cap and Utilities

Description:

- \$128K GF for payroll costs on 8 positions that exceed the federal pay cap & collective bargaining costs.
- \$92K GF for utilities and operational S&S. Higher optempo.

• FTE: 0

Impacts if not approved:

- Keep positions vacant.
- Potential layoff of one position.
- Increased deferred maintenance.
- Decreased ability to perform mission.



Cost:

• General Fund \$220,000



Policy Package 402 STARBASE Position

Description:

- Establishes one Training and Development Specialist 1 position and transfers 2 positions from Portland Air National Guard Base to Camp Rilea.
- FTE: 1.00, Positions: 1

Impact if not approved:

• Would limit the number of classes conducted at the Camp Rilea location.



Cost:

• Federal Funds \$162,456



Policy Package 304 OEM 9-1-1 Positions Limited Duration to Permanent

Description:

- Reclassify 2 OEM 9-1-1 Program Positions from Limited Duration to Permanent Full Time
- FTE: 2.00, Positions: 2



Impact if not approved:

 Project Management for future 9-1-1 initiatives that benefit Oregon's 43 Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) is jeopardized.

Cost:

• Other Funds \$487,724

Policy Packages 490, 491, 492 and 480 Capital Construction & Debt Service

Description:

- Salem & Pendleton Aviation Support Facilities Emergency Enhancements
- Salem Joint Force Headquarters & Anderson Readiness Center Upgrades
- Jackson Armory Service Life Extension
- Debt Service & Bond Costs for 5 Projects

Impact if not approved:

- Reduced ability to perform emergency response missions
- Deferred Maintenance backlog continues to increase
- Critical building infrastructure remains vulnerable to seismic failure



- General Fund \$533,528
- Other Funds \$20,230,000
- Federal Funds \$6,200,000



Governor's Budget Package 090 Additions



Policy Package 090 Addition OEM Resources for Resiliency 2025

Description:

- New Program Analyst 2 Incident Management Assistance Team (IMAT) Coordinator in OEM.
- Ensure 250,000 Oregon homes have a 2-week cache of earthquake emergency supplies
- \$500,000 GF for Risk Study of Critical Energy Infrastructure Hubs
- FTE: .88, Position: 1

Impact if not approved:

 Denies OEM resources needed to accomplish goals and objectives outlined in the Governor's Resiliency 2025 initiative



Cost:

• General Fund \$3,200,000



Policy Package 090 Addition Internal Auditor Position

Description:

- New Internal Auditor 3 position in Administration Program.
- Phase-in October 2019
- FTE: .88, Position: 1



Impact if not approved:

- OMD would continue to contract for internal audit services.
- Reduced audit coverage with contracted services, as opposed to a full-time employee.

Cost:

• General Fund \$199,772



Governor's Budget Package 090 Reductions (most impactful)



Policy Package 090 Public Affairs Reduction

Description:

- Abolishes OMD's only Public Affairs Specialist 2 position.
- Reduces GF Services & Supplies funding by \$19,420.
- \$19,420 S&S reduction doubledcounted (taken from Command Grp).
- FTE: (1.00), Position: (1)

Impacts if not approved:

- State staff in the Public Affairs office would be reduced to one part-time position.
- Increased delays in responding to public records requests.

• General Fund (\$271,323)



Policy Package 090 Command Group Reduction

Description:

- Reduces GF Services & Supplies funding by \$103,313.
- \$19,420 double-counted S&S reduction in Public Affairs was applied to the Command Group.
- Leaves \$26,281 for operational S&S.
- FTE: 0

Impacts if not approved:

 Reduces funding for office supplies, IT support, interest costs on Treasury Line of Credit, and DOJ costs.



Cost:

• General Fund (\$122,733)



Capital Construction Proposed new limitation requests



- 1. Umatilla Wastewater/Water Supply:
 - Wastewater system:
 - Existing wastewater treatment facility does not meet effluent treatment standards.
 - OMD working with DEQ to design a new treatment system.
 - Water supply system:
 - Potable water is currently supplied by wells on Morrow County property. Easement allows OMD to use these wells.
 - New water supply lines will be installed to 2 different wells located on OMD property, replacing the existing water source.
 - **\$6,000,000 Federal Funds** approved by National Guard Bureau for both systems.
- 2. Boardman Tactical Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (TUAV) facility:
 - Construction of a military drone maintenance and training facility at the Boardman Bombing Range.
 - Includes TUAV maintenance bays, runways, fueling stations, administrative space.
 - **\$12,000,000 Federal Funds** approved by National Guard Bureau.
- **3.** Grants Pass Armory Service Life Extension Project (ASLEP):
 - **\$4,300,000 Federal Funds** approved by National Guard Bureau.
 - Will supplement \$3.27M Q-Bonds approved for this remodel/upgrade project.
