SLCH understands the importance of treating the root causes of disease as a path to reducing the health care epidemic in our state. As you are well aware, eating unhealthy food is one of these root causes. The American Medical Association addressed this issue in July 2017 with resolution that all US hospitals should:

- 1. Serve plant-based meals low in fat, salt and sugar
- 2. Eliminate all processed meats

A couple of years ago SLCH incorporated the CHIP (complete health improvement program) in our community.
