42% <u>At least 25% of their income is dedicated to child care</u>. 21% <u>50% or more of their income is consumed by child care</u>.

### Action is Needed

- 1. Streamline regulatory process that assists in lowering start-up costs/complications without compromising quality
- 2. Explore new methods of incentivizing land owners/lessors to accept child care businesses
- 3. Identify state lands for use as quality child care facilities
- 4. Match local funding for a Central Oregon pilot for a child care accelerator position
  - a. Develop employer pools to guarantee clientele
  - b. Identify & develop viable, quality providers
  - c. Align land owners, brokers, bankers, etc. to advance new facilities
