Our products are shipped all across Oregon, up to the Tacoma, WA area and all the way out to the Boise, ID market utilizing 15 commercial motor vehicles.

I write today to request your support for <u>HB 3209</u> and <u>SB 1021</u>. Both bills are important for the future infrastructure improvements needed to help alleviate this area's constant increase in vehicle traffic. Our delivery trucks travel the very roads being proposed in these bills Sunday-Friday.
