Yes to a National Popular Vote!

All Americans, not just those in swing states, should elect the president. I think that we should elect the president using a National Popular Vote and that the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact is the best way to do that.

It is a misconception that under a National Popular Vote certain areas would 'decide' the election. In fact, that's what happens now. National Popular Vote fixes this inequality by making every voter's vote matter.

The House has supported similar legislation at least three times in past sessions. Please vote SB 870 out of committee and allow it to go to the House floor for a vote.
