Honorable Chair Holvey and Committee Members,

Please vote No on SB870, the National Popular Vote bill. It should go before the voters if you intend to make it part of Oregon law.

This bill gives control of Oregon Electoral Votes to people outside of our state., which goes completely against the founders idea based on <u>Federalist paper number 68</u>, where they stated that they did not even want the electors to leave the state they represented for fear of outside influence. They wanted these votes to truly represent the will of the local state voters.
