

Dear Senators,

Please vote no in SB761. Reading this bill it makes changes to the initiative petition process.

Eliminating other access used to easily allow your constituents to participate in our DEMOCRATIC process greatly REDUCES participation. This bill, if it becomes law, removes the trust we have in our elected officials. This bill would allow you to freely pass bills that are Unconstitutional and would affect Oregon citizens and our rights! Limiting our voices in opposition of any Bill is contradictory to the reason our Government was established, which is to protect and support the Rights of Citizens.

Why would we need an emergency clause in this? I would like clear reasoning on how a Bill like this protects the Rights of Oregon Citizens.
