- Nine members appointed to three-year terms by the Governor:
  - Five members shall be current or former consumers of home care services for the elderly or persons with disabilities (GUEDON, JOHNSON, MAYFIELD, SCHWARTZ -VANZANDT, VOLPE, WENTZELL)
  - One member shall be a representative of the Oregon Disabilities Commission
  - One member shall be a representative of the Governor's Commission on Senior Services (MCEWEN)
  - One member shall be a representative of the Oregon Association of Area Agencies on Aging and Disabilities (MOORE)
  - One member shall be a representative of the Department of Human Services (JOHNSON)
- Members are eligible for reappointment and may serve no more than three consecutive terms

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:** ORS 410.602 to 410.625

- Ensure the quality of home care services
- Establish qualifications for home care workers with the advice and consent of the Department of Human Services
- Provide training opportunities for home care workers, and for elderly and disabled persons who employ home care workers
- Establish and maintain a registry of qualified home care workers
- Provide routine, emergency and respite referrals of home care workers
- Enter into contracts with public and private organizations and individuals for the purpose of obtaining or developing training materials and curriculum or other services as may be needed by the commission
- Work cooperatively with area agencies and state and local agencies
- The Department of Human Services shall appoint a department employee as executive director for the commission, subject to approval by the commission
- For purposes of collective bargaining, the Home Care Commission is the employer of record for home care workers
