- Seven members serve at the pleasure of the Governor, state residents, eligible for reappointment.
- One member of the commission from each congressional district,
 - First District ZARNOWITZ
 - Second District BITTLE
 - Third District WOLLEY
 - o Fourth District WAHL
 - o Fifth District SPELBRINK
- One member from that portion of the state lying west of the Cascade Mountains (NASH)
- One member from that portion of the state lying east of the Cascade Mountains (LABHART)
- Have a general knowledge of fish and wildlife issues and an understanding of the operation and functions of public policy boards and commissions.
- In making appointments to the commission, the Governor is to consider appointing members who possess
 natural resource backgrounds such as commercial fishing, recreational fishing, hunting, agriculture, forestry
 and conservation.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS Chapters 496, 497, 498 and 501

- Provide for the productive and sustainable utilization of wildlife resources for all users.
- Represent the public interest of the state
- Make decisions affecting the wildlife resources of the state for the benefit of those resources.
- Appoint State Fish and Wildlife Director
- Make biennial report to Governor and Legislative Assembly
- Formulate and implement policies and programs for the management of wildlife
- Adopt rules and standards

- Hold at least one meeting per year in each of the congressional districts in Oregon
- Acquire, introduce, propagate and stock wildlife species
- Establish licenses, tags and permits for angling, hunting and trapping and prescribe tagging and sealing procedures
- May establish special hunting and angling areas or seasons for old or young people
- Establish preference system for individuals who are unsuccessful in controlled hunt permit drawings for deer and elk hunting have reasonable assurance of success in those drawings in subsequent years
- Acquire by purchase, lease, agreement, gift or exercise of eminent domain for wildlife management and recreation purposes
- Sell and exchange state property
- Establish and develop wildlife refuge and management areas
- Set fees for licenses, tags, permits and applications
- Enter into contracts to develop and encourage wildlife research and management
- Establish cooperative wildlife management programs with federal government.
- Offer rewards for the arrest and conviction of people who violate wildlife laws
- Establish hunting seasons and areas
- Conduct salmon and trout enhancement programs
- Employ wildlife enforcement officers with the approval of the Governor and Superintendent of State Police
- Institute suits for recovery of damages for the unlawful taking or killing of wildlife
- Appoint agents for issuance of licenses, tags or permits
- Revoke licenses, tags and permits
- Adopt rules establishing schedule of civil penalties for violations of wildlife laws or rules adopted by the Commission.
