- Created under section 2821(b) and (c) of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 to assist in the development of the State Unified Workforce Plan established under ORS 660.324 and to carry out the other functions described by the federal Act.
- Membership shall be in accordance with the requirements of section 2821(b) of the federal Act.
- Representatives of business described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act who are appointed to the board shall be subject to Senate confirmation.
- Governor selects the chairperson according to 2821(c) of the federal Act.
- A majority of the board shall be representatives of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.
- Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the board are nonvoting members of the boards and may act in an advisory capacity only.
- To transact business at a meeting of the board, a quorum of voting members must participate. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the voting members. At least 25 percent of the members participating shall be representative of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.
- Members are:
 - Two Senators appointed by the Senate President (DEMBROW, THATCHER)
 - Two Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House (HOLVEY)
 - Business representative positions are appointed by Governor from nominations of business organizations and business trade association (MADDEN, MERSEREAU, NAGASUBRAMANIAN, O'NEILL, PARSONS, POOL, RADIE, REYNOLDS, ROST, VENKATRAMAN, WALL, WEBER)
 - Chief elected officials (representing both cities and counties, where appropriate) (DORROH, HUNT)
 - Representatives of labor organizations nominated by state labor federations (BYRD, MILLARD)
 - Representatives of individuals or organizations that have experience with youth activities
 - Representatives of individuals or organizations with experience and expertise in delivery of workforce investment activities, including chief executive officers of community colleges or community-based organizations (BELISLE, DAZEY, DUNN, LEE, MITSUI)
 - Serving by position: Governor (BROWN), Director of Community Colleges and Workforce
 Development (CRANE), Director of Employment Department (ERICKSON), Director of Business
 Development Department (HARDER), Executive Director of Higher Education Coordinating
 Commission (CANNON)
 - Additional member representing elected officials, labor organizations or youth activities
 - Additional members can be appointed by the Governor if required to comply with federal law

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 660.324

- Develop and submit to the Governor, a single, unified state plan that outlines a strategy with quantitative
 goals, for the statewide workforce investment system for the State of Oregon in accordance with section
 2821 of the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998. Upon the Governor's approval of the state plan,
 the Governor shall cause the State Unified Workforce Plan to be delivered to the Legislative Assembly.
- The board shall develop and include in the state plan goals designed to promote Oregonians' self-sufficiency.
- Assist Governor in:
 - o Developing Oregon's workforce investment system
 - o Ensuring timely consultation and collaboration with chief elected officials, local workforce investment boards and other workforce stakeholders,
 - o Reviewing local workforce plans
 - o Complying with provisions of the federal Act
