Subject: HB 2006 – Relating to housing

HB 2006A funds grants to support programs related to tenant and landlord education services, fair housing training, innovations that help low income Oregonians and survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault find and access available rental housing, and legal services. The bill is subsequently referred from the House Committee on Rules, where it was approved on a vote of 5-1.

The -A8 amendment includes a General Fund appropriation to the Housing and Community Services Department in the amount of \$3,000,000 for the services to low income Oregonians, per Section 1(17) of the bill, a \$3,000,000 General Fund appropriation to the Department of Justice for assistance to survivors, as outlined in Section 2(4). The amendments also make adjustments to correct a reference made in SB 608 related to notice that must be given to tenants when terminating tenancy, and clarify that landlords with four or fewer rental units aren't subject to provisions of SB 608.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A8 amendments.
