## SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

## SB 884 Relating to the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund

SB 884 expands qualified uses of the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, which is administered by the Department of Environmental Quality. The fund provides belowmarket rate loans for water pollution control activities.

This bill will allow certified community development financial institutions to receive monies from the fund in order to finance projects to repair or replace failing on-site septic systems.

DEQ anticipates that funding resources and current staffing levels are sufficient to cover the needs of newly eligible recipients and no additional expenditure limitation is required at this time.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends SB 884 be reported out do pass.
