#### Measure Description:

Permits Oregon State Lottery to pay prizes to trustee of trust at written request of prize winner. Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission to adopt rules necessary to ensure compliance with reporting requirements, constitutional requirements, or other applicable law when paying prize to trustee.

### Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is submitted to transmit the measure from the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure would permit the Oregon State Lottery (the Lottery) to pay prizes to the trustee of a trust at the written request from the prize winner. The Oregon State Lottery Commission (the Commission) would need to adopt administrative rules to ensure compliance with reporting requirements, constitutional requirements, or other applicable laws when paying a prize to a trustee. It would authorize the Commission, by rule, to specify service fees that may be charged for lottery tickets or shares, not to exceed 30 percent of the retail sales price of the ticket or share, in addition to the retail sales price and any other fees required by law. The measure would also prohibit the Commission from offering a "sports betting game," unless tickets or shares for the game are purchased exclusively from equipment that is owned or leased by the Lottery, the operation of which is subject to and in compliance with the amusement device excise tax.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon State Lottery.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Rules.
