Subject: HB 2352 – Relating to boats
Work Session Recommendations

The legislation creates a Towed Watersports Program within the Oregon State Marine Board and authorizes the collection of a fee, estimated at \$124, for the issuance and renewal of a two-year towed watersports endorsement decal. Agents may be appointed to issue the endorsement and collect the fee with an additional \$2 service charge. Fees collected must support the costs of administering and implementing the towed water sports program and to assist with paying the costs of law enforcement activities related to towed watersports. Owners of motorboats within water of the Newberg Pool Congested Zone are required to display the towed watersports endorsement; failure to do so is a Class B violation.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -5 amendment which tasks the Marine Board to define wake surfing or wakeboarding by rule, restricts the endorsements to only the Newberg Pool Congested Zone, and provides Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Marine Board in the 2019-21 biennium.

MOTION: I move adoption of the -5 amendment to HB 2352. (VOTE)
