I enthusiastically support passing House Bill 2001 for the following reasons.

- **Oregon's current zoning laws are harming the state every day.** Re-legalizing duplexes, triplexes and fourplexes will shift market-rate construction in low-density areas away from luxury mansions and toward middle housing that's affordable to the middle class from day one.
- Legalizing missing-middle makes every dollar of funding for below-market housing go further. That's why it's backed by nonprofit developers like Habitat for Humanity, PCRI and Hacienda CDC.
