Work Session Recommendations

The measure creates a Towed Watersports Program within the Oregon State Marine Board and authorizes the collection of a fee, estimated at \$124, for the issuance and renewal of a two-year towed watersports endorsement decal. Fees collected must support the the costs of administering and implementing the program and to assist with paying the costs of law enforcement activities related to towed watersports. The towed watersports program is limited to the waters of the Newberg Pool Congested Zone.

**Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -6 amendment that will limit endorsement to the Newberg Pool Congested Zone and provides \$124,001 Other Funds limitation to implement the requirements of the bill.
