

HB 2352
Relating to boats

HB 2352 creates a Towed Watersports Program within the Oregon State Marine Board for the Newberg Pool Congested Zone.

The Marine Board is authorized to collect a fee, estimated at \$124, for the issuance and renewal of a two-year towed watersports endorsement decal.

Agents may be appointed to issue the endorsement and collect the fee with an additional \$2 service charge.

Fees collected must support the costs of administering and implementing the towed water sports program and to assist with paying the costs of law enforcement activities related to towed watersports.

Owners of motorboats within water of the Newberg Pool Congested Zone are required to display the towed watersports endorsement; failure to do so is a Class B violation.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 2352 be amended by the -6 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
