Over 20 years I have done research in injury, including bicycle and pedestrian injuries with multiple peer reviewed publications and white papers. Peer reviewed publications such as the dated but decent 2010 study from UC Berkeley and the Idaho implementing the law there was NO evidence of increase in injury or fatality rates after adoption of the 1982 law.
