Dear Rules Committee:

RE: SB 998 | Bikes May Yield at Traffic Control Device

I am writing you today to **strongly urge the committee to please pass SB 998.** This is important legislation that codifies and legalizes the safe way in which competent bicyclists treat stop signs and other traffic control devices. Bicyclists simply cannot accelerate from a full stop in the same way that a motor vehicle with an internal combustion engine can. That time in which a bicyclist is re-starting puts a bicyclist in danger from cars. Enforcement of the current law is a drain upon the limited resources of courts and our enforcement officers.
