Subject: HB 2377 – Relating to state financial administration (Program Change)
Work Session Recommendation

HB 2377 relates to state financial administration. An amendment replaces the bill. The amended version is referred to as the “Program Change” bill. The bill has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

The bill as amended implements the statutory changes necessary to support the 2019-21 legislatively adopted budget and to clarify the application of statutes. The bill is not an appropriation bill and therefore does not include the appropriation of funds.

The fiscal or budgetary impacts of provisions of this bill are contained in HB 5050 (budget reconciliation) and HB 5029 (Lottery Fund/Criminal Fines Account/Marijuana Account allocations) for the 2019-21 biennium, or in specific agency budget bills.

A preliminary staff measure summary and fiscal impact are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). A revenue impact statement is being prepared for the bill.

An -A6 amendment replaces the bill.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A6 amendment.

MOTION: I move adoption of the -A6 amendment to HB 2377. (VOTE)

LFO recommends that HB 2377, as amended by the -A6 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
