Subject: HB 5050 Budget Reconciliation Work Session Recommendations

HB 5050 is the budget reconciliation bill that implements the remaining pieces of the state budget for the 2019-21 biennium. The bill establishes appropriations for the Emergency Board, finalizes the General Fund components of the statewide budget, implements budgetary changes tied to other legislation, and makes technical adjustments to agency budgets previously approved.

Key elements, including General Fund appropriations for specific agencies or purposes, are listed below.

- \$75 million general purpose Emergency Fund appropriation to the Emergency Board.
- Special purpose appropriations to the Emergency Board for state employee compensation changes (\$200 million), for state agencies related to non-state employee compensation changes (\$20 million).
- A total of \$30 million General Fund and Lottery Funds for cash grants to various community projects.
- A \$20 million Special Purpose Appropriation to the Emergency Board for Public Defense Services Commission.
- \$10 million General Fund for a University Innovation Research Fund
- \$6.7 million to the Oregon Health Authority for medical assistance inflation.
- \$6 million for community mental health programs
- \$5 million Lottery Funds for operating and research expenses at the Oregon Manufacturing and Innovation Center.
- \$3.5 million to extend the Parent-Child Representation Program to Multnomah County for the second year of the biennium.
- \$2 million increase in the Strategic Reserve Fund.
- \$1.7 million General Fund to stop the spread of Sudden Oak Death.
- \$1.4 million Other Funds to continue operations of Leaburg Hatchery.

The amendment also contains standard statewide adjustments done every biennium that reduce charges to agencies by DAS and DOJ created by legislatively adopted reductions to these agency budgets and debt service adjustments based on updated debt service schedules.

There are also six proposed budget notes which are posted on OLIS.

Recommended Changes
