Measure Description:

Modifies juvenile code to prohibit placement of children and wards taken into protective custody in detention facilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee Human Services to the Senate Committee Judiciary.

The measure modifies juvenile code to prohibit placement of children and wards taken into protective custody in detention facilities. This prohibition includes “runaway” children.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Youth Authority, the Department of Human Services, and the Oregon Judicial Department.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in Senate Committee Judiciary.
