WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes any city to define "area" as a city in which a property is located, for the purposes of certain ad valorem property taxation statutes. Applies to assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2021, or to assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2020 with the written consent of the county assessor. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, cities in which a majority of their population reside in a county with a population greater than 700,000 may define "area" as a city in which a property is located, for the purposes of certain ad valorem property taxation statutes.

House Bill 3068 would authorize any city to define "area" as a city in which a property is located, for the purposes of certain ad valorem property taxation statutes.
